Grenoble Applied Economics Laboratory (GAEL) is proud to organize the **42**nd **Applied Microeconomics Days**, to be held on

June 4 and 5, 2026

on the Campus of Université Grenoble Alpes at Saint-Martin-d'Hères.

The purpose of this two-day conference is to bring together academics and researchers to present and discuss their ongoing research, and to stimulate interaction and cooperation between them. Topics with an interest in the broad area of applied microeconomics are covered: consumer and demand analysis, behavioral and experimental economics, industrial economics, organizational economics, innovation economics, labor, education, migration economics, health, family economics, public economics, spatial economics, transportations, finance, risk and insurance, development economics, welfare economics, agricultural economics, environmental and resources economics, law and economics, applied micro econometrics, public policy evaluation, etc.

The keynote lecture will be given by Jérôme Adda, Professor of Economics at Bocconi University.

The JMA's **job market** will give the opportunity to PhD candidates and post-doctoral researchers to signal themselves in the program as candidates for the next recruitment campaigns.

The Revue économique will devote a special issue for this conference in September 2027.

Submission procedure

The scientific committee will consider complete papers, even preliminary versions. Papers should be submitted under the following link: jma2026.sciencesconf.org

The first page must contain: (i) the title of the paper, (ii) first and last names of presenter/co-author(s), (iii) an abstract, (iv) key words, (v) JEL codes, (vi) affiliation, postal address, and e-mail address of the corresponding author.

Deadline for submission of papers: February 1st, 2026. Notification of acceptance of paper: before April 2026.
